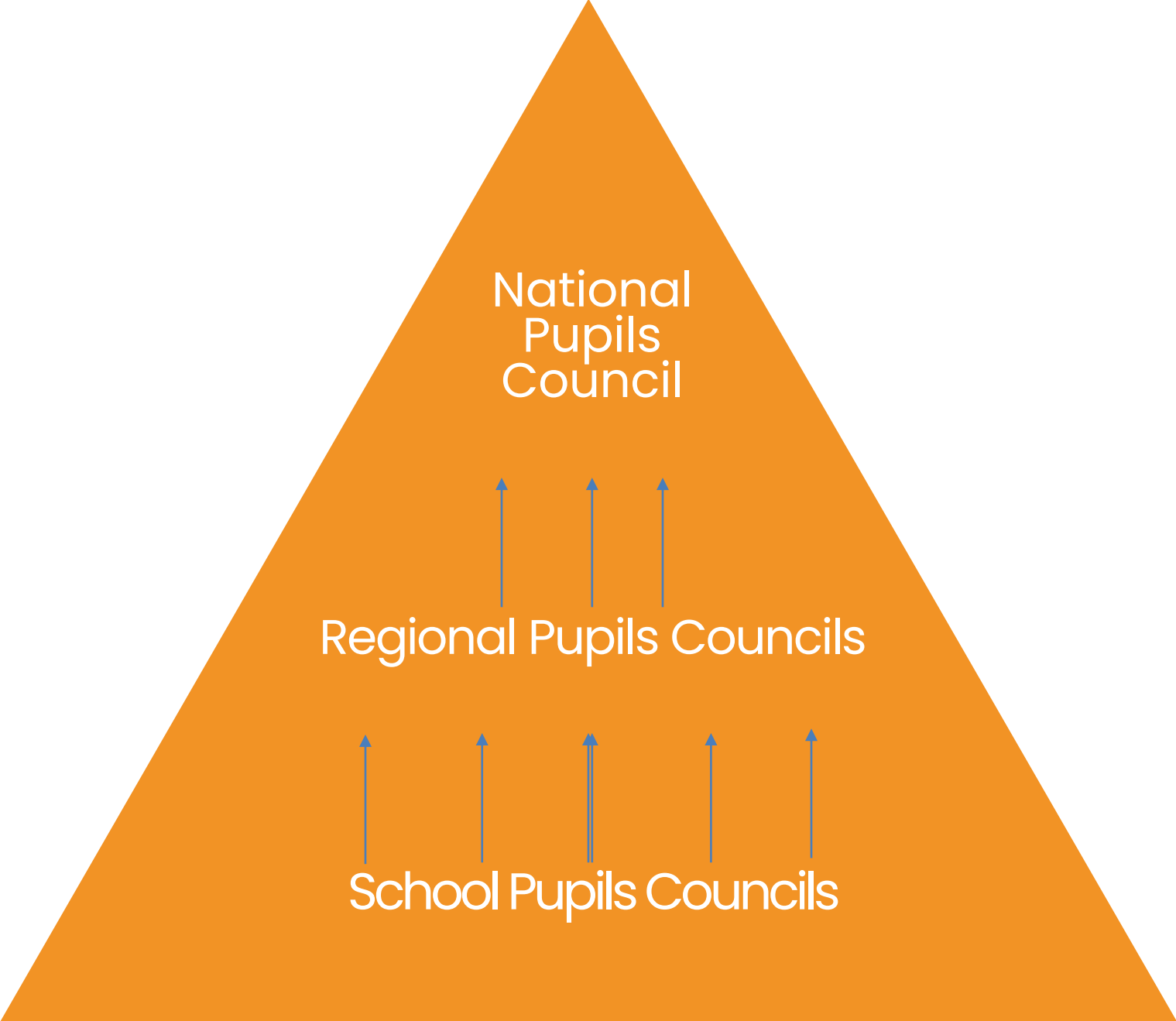

# Pupils Councils Structure



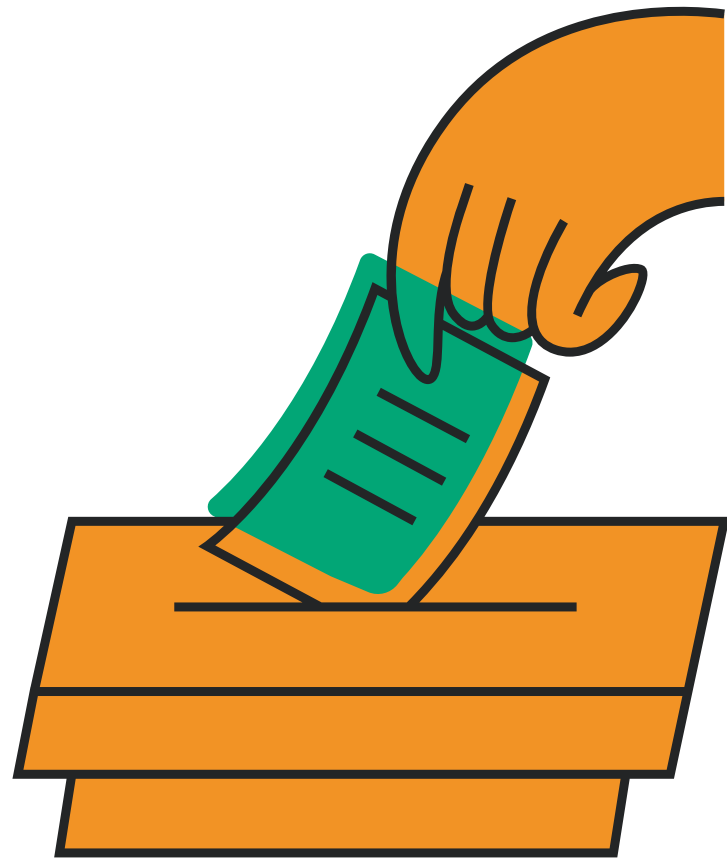
Democratic Elections in Schools

Purpose of the campaign – to create a traditional event centered around the values of democratic participation, rooted from the school years.

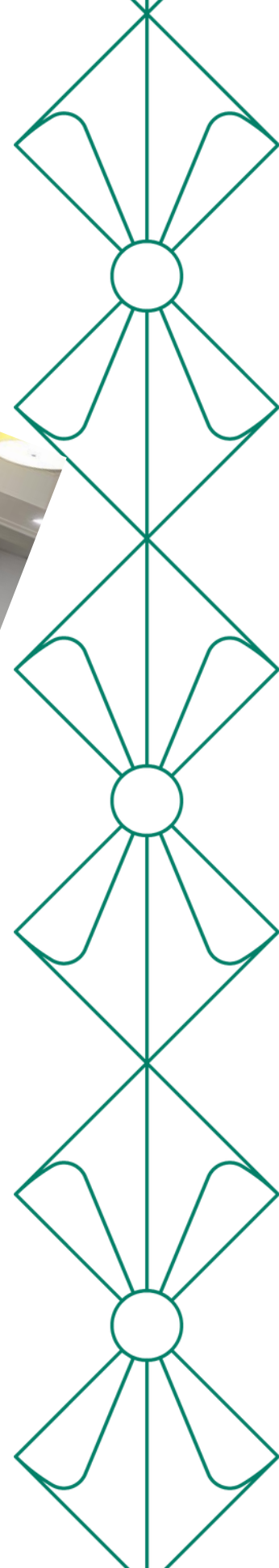


# Support program for strengthening Student Councils



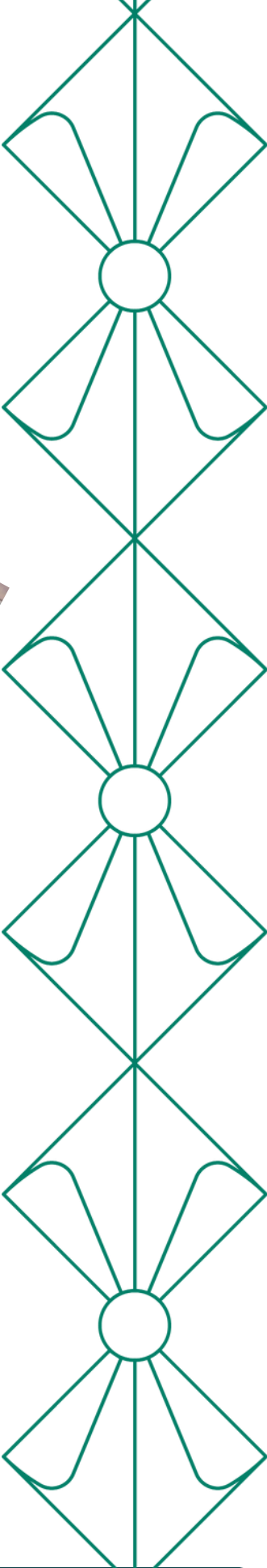
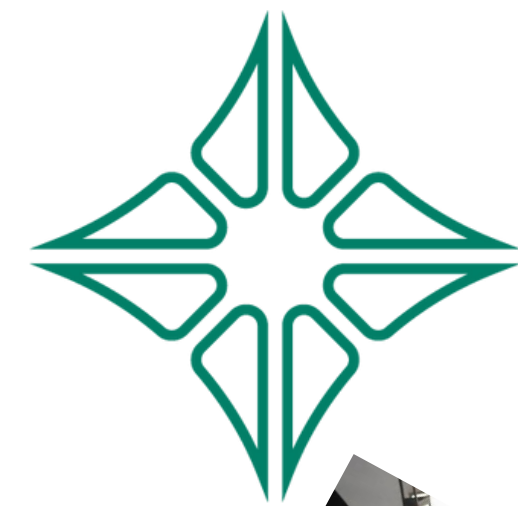

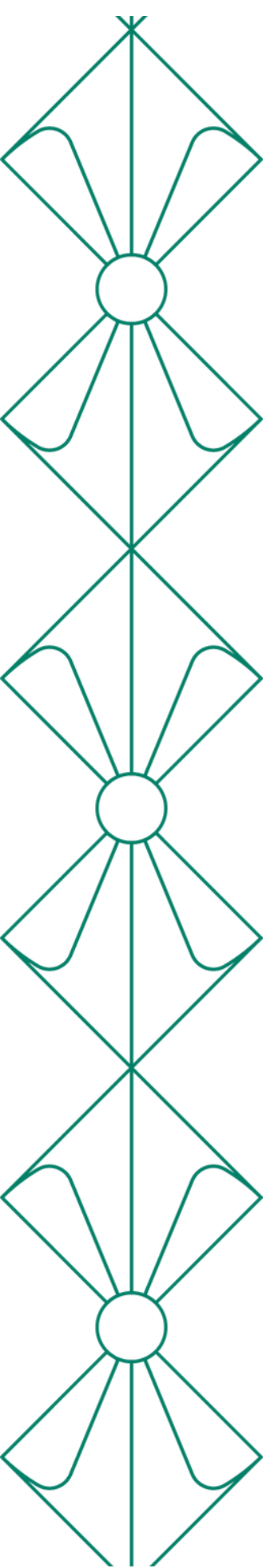
Support program dedicated to students, teachers and managerial staff in institutions. Implementation period – 2025 – 2028



# Results and the human stories behind them

- 700 schools applied for the program in first year of implementation
- 200 schools went through the training program
- 70 schools and 75 IPT pupils projects financed
- Over 300 schools covered in informational campaign
- Elections in over 1000 schools simultaneously
- School radio, youth spaces, educational activities, podcasts, red boxes and a looooot of other cool stuff!
