Providing a personal assistant service

Employment programs for unemployed people

The purpose of the program is to support unemployed persons who to obtain professional skills and abilities in accordance with the requirements presented by the employer.

Program components:

- Professional training
- Gaining professional work experience
- Lump sum compensation to the employer



A program aimed at providing support to the agricultural economy through the promotion of seasonal employment

Purpose:

is mitigation the social tension of the population of rural areas and providing conditions for their stable employment.

The cost of the project cannot be lower than 50 thousand AMD, and exceed 350 thousand Dram.



The maximum duration of the program is 180 days.



Providing a personal assistant service

Providing a personal assistant service:

A personal assistant can be any adult and able-bodied person who has attended training courses for personal assistants and has a certificate certifying it.

The personal assistant service is provided by:

by involving a person with a disability or a person chosen by his legal representative as a personal assistant;

The personal assistant service includes:

care of the beneficiary.

support the beneficiary to overcome environmental barriers (including mobility and communication).



Work Permit in the Republic of Armenia

Foreigners have the right to freely manage their working abilities, to choose a profession and type of activity, to engage in economic activities not prohibited by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia, observing the restrictions set by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia. The principle of equality of rights of the parties to labor relations established by the Labor Code of the Republic of Armenia is guaranteed, regardless of their gender, race, nationality, language, citizenship and other circumstances unrelated to the practical characteristics of the employee.

In the Republic of Armenia, there is a system of issuing a work permit for a foreign worker, which is fully implemented electronically.

Work permit - allows a foreigner to obtain a temporary residence status and work in the Republic of Armenia.



Trainings

The Unified Social Service regularly organizes trainings for employment specialists of regional centers on issues related to labor migration in order to provide migrant beneficiaries with information and advice on their rights.
